

Welcome to "Where World's Woulda Been"!!

This will be a written version of what I will be reading in the Facebook Live Players Meeting on Friday evening at 7 pm. It can be viewed on the Premier Design Disc Golf group. If you are not member, please send a request and I will approve it. If you are not on Facebook, please consider this your player's meeting.

COVID-19 – As everyone is aware, all players are expected to maintain social distancing at all venues. If you cannot stay at least 6 ft away from others, please wear a mask. **It is my main concern that all players have a safe and enjoyable weekend!!** Spectators and caddies are allowed and should also obey all COVID-19 related regulations.

All players are respectfully requested to ask themselves the following COVID-19 questions before arriving on Saturday morning...

Have you been diagnosed with or suspected of having COVID-19?

Have you been in close contact with a confirmed case in the past 14 days?

Have you had a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher in the last 48 hours?

Are you experiencing a cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat?

Are you experiencing chills, unexplained muscle aches, headaches, or fatigue?

Have you had a new loss of appetite or loss of taste or smell?

Have you had nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea in the last 24 hours?

If you answer "Yes" to any of these questions, please withdraw from the event. A full refund will be given, no questions asked.

All counties in our region currently have mask requirements when in public. Restaurants are open for indoor seating, patrons are requested to wear masks until seated.

Over the last few weeks, I have sent out emails with course info sheets and maps to make things easier for players. Please go back and find these emails, download all useful info to your phone or print copies. Check the junk or spam folders if you cannot find the emails from me. No hard copies of any of these will be available at the course. If you are playing any course for the first time, please refer to the parking assistance maps, they will help you park in the lot closest to your starting hole. **Age protected divisions will get priority hole assignments (shortest walk).**

All courses are open for practice this week. Harmon is a private, pay-to-play, course. Fees are \$10 per day, but fees will be waived on Friday. Primitive camping is available at Harmon, free to players for the weekend. There will be a Port-O in the camping area and beside the house.

After the players meeting, I will post Round 1 starting hole assignments for both Pools. Rd 1 & 2 are shotgun start. There will be no player check-in on Saturday morning. There will be no scoreboards at either course. All scores, hole assignments, start times, and tee times will be online at the link provided below. A tent and table will be near Hole 1 at both courses with scorecards and pencils. Your Pool TD will be there as well to answer any questions. Pool A TD is Tim Barr (423-943-7454), Pool B TD is Kenny Kitchings (423-571-4730). Please contact them if you cannot attend or if any problems arise. **It will be the responsibility of all players to know what course to play, what hole to start on, and when the start time is.** This can all be found at - <https://www.pdga.com/tour/event/45852>

Each group is requested to set up Online Scoring - <https://www.pdga.com/apps/tournament/score/login>

The code is - tennessee

Players that cannot access online scoring should use the hard copy scorecards available at each course.

Only one person per group should handle the card.

The more groups that use online, the faster hole assignments will be posted.

Please double-check all scores before submitting!!

Round 2 start times and hole assignments will be posted as soon as possible after completion of Round 1. All players will have a minimum of 1 hour and 40 mins for lunch, determined by the last card turned in at their course. Drive time between Sugar Hollow and Winged Deer is roughly 40 mins. Player's should try to find a quick stop on the way or pack their own lunches.

Round 3 tee times will be posted as soon as possible following completion of Round 2. Round 3 will be at Harmon Hills for both Pools. Tee times will begin at 8 am Sunday morning. **Age Protected Divisions will have earliest tee times.** All other divisions will have later times.

Online scoring at Harmon is difficult. Players who have Verizon or Sprint will not get a signal. Players who have AT&T will have a good signal. There will be a hotspot set up at the starters tent. Players can access it before the round and set up scoring. During the round, the app will keep the score without

getting a signal. When your group finishes, come back to the starters table and re-access the hotspot to submit scores. There will be hard copy cards for all groups as well.

All payout will be online. When your group finishes Round 3, you are free to leave. On Monday morning, Ams that cashed will get an email from me with a coupon code to - <https://www.dynamicdiscs.com/>

Players can then use the code to shop for the amount of their winnings. Be sure to check your email Monday morning!

Pro payout will be via PayPal or Venmo. Pros should expect payment Monday afternoon, when I am finished with Am emails. Please give me your credentials before teeing off in Round 3.

\$5 from each entry fee goes to course fees.

There will be 2 Port-O's at all courses. Sugar Hollow – Holes 3 and 14 tee.

Winged Deer – Holes 1 and 9 tee.

Harmon Hills – Pavilion area and House area

There will be no water at any course (thanks covid), please be sure to bring enough water and snacks!

The weather forecast is for temps in the mid 80's with a chance of thunderstorms in the afternoons. If storms come up, the Pool TD will be in charge of stopping play. In the event of lightning, play will cease immediately. Play will begin again as soon as the TD feels it is safe. Be sure to check in with TD, 30 mins after play was stopped.
