# The Woods TPC



The Woods TPC is aptly named. Lots and lots of trees in play create an almost classic Disc Golf course feel. Being a Hybrid course though, it still requires distance and placement accuracy.

# The Woods TPC

All Golf Greens are OB. The primary cut (actual putting surface ) is the OB line. The fringe is In Bounds. All Bunkers are Not OB. Play from where it lies. Please rake bunkers. The road on Holes 4, 5, 10, and 11 is OB. Hole 12 has a Mando. Miss mando, re-tee with stroke penalty. Parking Lot behind Hole 12 basket is OB. Pros will play the Island Green on Hole 16. Miss green, re-tee with stroke penalty.

# Hole 1



Hole 1 opens up The Woods with a slightly uphill two shot hole for all skill levels. A 3 on Hole 1 will be very satisfying as it will require a long drive and an accurate approach. Slightly ironic that Hole 1 on a course called *The Woods* has a lone cedar guarding the basket!

# Hole 2



Hole 2 offers a blind drive over and around the golf green to a basket perched on a left to right slope.

The tree line on the right is a hazard zone, shots that cross the flag line are Not OB. Play your next shot from where it crossed the line or best estimation if your group is not sure because of the hill obstructing your view.

# Hole 3



Hole 3 continues a Premier Design staple, the big downhill Bomb!

Let 'er rip but be sure to avoid the green behind the basket!

Keep carts on cart path on this hole please!

The hill is too steep.

# Hole 4



Lefty hyzers and Righty sidearms will like Hole 4! A big downhill drive that finishes inside the treeline is the preferred shot.

Once inside the trees the rough on the right can be bad. The street is OB but shouldn't come into play.

# Hole 5



Hole 5 is quite possibly one of the most difficult short holes we have ever played on a Hybrid layout.

Extremely tight and wooded with road OB all the way down the right side. Pick your line carefully as there are many tiny options to complement the main fairway, that may take the OB out of play. Hit the right side of a tree, expect to be OB.

# Hole 6




Hole 6 will be a welcome, wide open relief! Bust out an accurate uphill drive and card a 2!

But be prepared, Hole 7 makes Hole 5 look easy!

# Hole 7



Hole 7 is a beast. Uphill, long, and very wooded, if you get a 3 on Hole 7 you should be very pleased. It will take a monster, uber accurate drive to have a chance at a 2. 307 ft may seem reachable but the combination of tight fairway and uphill drive combine to make Hole 7 one of the toughest pars on the course!

# Hole 8




Hole 8 gives you another chance to bust out a long, downhill drive. Be aware of the rough at the bottom of the hill on the right. Second shots will have to negotiate some big trees with low limbs to reach the basket on top of the hill. 3's on Hole 8 will be very satisfying!

# Hole 9



Hole 9 has a unique feature. A big limb out of a pine tree has broken and sagged over to the ground. It left a very cool natural archway that because of the position of the tee, forces players to throw under it!

Relatively short and basically a triple mando, (although it's not, don't panic!) Hole 9 is a lot of fun!

# Hole 10



Wide open an undulating, Hole 10 is a longish birdie opportunity that also has a downhill element.

The road on the right is OB but, once again, shouldn't come into play.

# Hole 11



Hole 11 requires a controlled fairway drive through a nice tree lined alley. The basket sits out in the golf fairway at the bottom of a deep depression. Reachable but difficult, a 2 on Hole 11 will be tough to get.

# Hole 12



Hole 12 is one of the few, if any, Mando holes you will find on a Premier Design layout. But when you stand on the tee, the reasoning is clear. Without the mando, everyone would just throw a big hyzer around the pine on the right. Well, we can't have that! Keep your shot low, make the mando, and get that rewarding 2! Miss the mando, re-tee with stroke penalty. Parking lot behind basket is OB.

# Hole 13



No mandos on Hole 13, or any other remaining hole, for that matter! Just a nice crank over a blind hill to a basket sitting out in the middle of a huge green fairway. It will take some imagination to get a drive close so pick out a nice aiming point and let it fly!

# Hole 14



Hole 14 hands you another tree lined fairway that is downhill as well. This hole is reachable for most skill levels and should be a great chance to get a 2. Enjoy, this hole is sweet, a no brainer design as soon as we saw it!

Lots of trees guard the basket on Hole 15. Plenty of room off the tee but then things change. Find the alley that looks good to you then grip it and rip it! Yet another good opportunity for a 2.

# Hole 16



Hole 16's green will remind players of the green on the fabled Hole 17 at Sawgrass TPC on the PGA Tour, without the water. The green is a golf tee box that is built up on the front with railroad timbers. The basket sits close to the front edge so if your drive goes long, expect a knee knocker comeback putt. Pros will find even more difficulty as the hole will play as an island, drives must land on the other side of the cart path. Reaching the island shouldn't be a problem. Miss the island, re-tee with stroke penalty. Ams and Ladies have nothing to fear as they will NOT play island rules.

Par 3 for all divisions.

# Hole 17



Hole 17 will demand a long uphill drive in order to be able to reach the basket in two shots. Lots of trees force players to stay right of the rough and shoot for the gap that leads to the basket. Card a 3 and smile all the way to 18's tee!

# Hole 18



Hole 18 promises to be a hoot! A big downhill drive into a huge valley, over the rollercoaster fairway and into the triple tree guarded basket. Drives that stay right will have a big uphill second shot but will be closer to the green. Drives that stay left will have a more level second shot but will be farther away from the green. Pick your poison. Once again, a 3 on the card will gain a stroke on lots of players!
