## What is required to Adopt-A-Hole?

Players who choose to Adopt-A-Hole will be asked to...

1. Report any large tree falls or damage that is too big for one person to handle to Tim Barr.
2. Keep the hole clean of trash. If the trash can is full, contact Tim, who will then contact the Park.
3. Keep the hole clean of debris (small limbs, sticks, etc).
4. Weedeat when necessary. Contact Tim if you need to borrow one.
5. Under NO CIRCUMSTANCE should a volunteer cut trees or limbs without prior approval from Tim.
6. Basket bands can be cleaned but with soap and water only. Chemicals may damage the powder coating.
7. Keep the hole clean of briars or scrub stuff that grows up from stumps.
8. Chainsaws are permitted but ONLY with Tim and Park approval. Ask Tim first, he will confirm with Park.

We all know that Warriors Path is far and away the most played course in our region.

If we all band together, we can restore her to her former glory!
