

TD Checklist and Timeline

Items needed – tent, table, air horn,
pencils, scorecards

(Please do your best to make each time checkpoint)

(Tim will provide)

Do not hesitate to text or call me at anytime.

Prior to arriving, please purchase 15 gallons of water.

You may fill up coolers at your home if that is easier. Be sure to keep any receipts, you will be paid back.

8 am – Arrive at course, please be on time

8:15 am – Fill water coolers for volunteers. They will distribute the water.

8:45 am – Have tent, table, scorecards, pencils set up for players

9 am – Be at HQ to answer questions, direct players to starting hole, etc

Digital scoring code is "river".

2 players must keep score, either on a card or digitally.

If a group uses hardcopy scoring, be sure to keep the card, take a picture and send to me asap.

Players may access digital scoring via pdga.com/score

They can also download the pdga scoring app

9:58 am – 2 blasts on air horn for 2-minute warning

10 am – 1 long blast to start play.

From start of play until all groups are done, stay close to HQ so if players need you, they can find you.

If there are any rules questions that you cannot answer, call me asap.

Most groups should be able to figure things out but don't hesitate to call me if needed.

During play, go to - <https://www.pdga.com/tour/event/64545> and click on the live scoring icon so you can keep up with your divisions and when all groups are finished with play.

Be sure to familiarize yourself with what divisions are playing your course that day.

When all groups are done with the round, text me so I know.

After that - gather all water coolers, pack up all gear and call it a day.
